We opened our doors in 2004 as a project of Southeast Healthcare, a comprehensive provider of mental health services, primary care, dental care, alcohol and drug addiction services, vocational services, and homeless services that began operations in Franklin County in 1978. Fresh A.I.R. displays between five and eight exhibits per year at multiple community venues.

We support artists through every step of the exhibit process. Through their experiences with us, many artists develop the resources and confidence they need to advance their artistic careers, as well as their journeys away from stigma and toward healing.
